All parties (Complainant, Respondent, and Witness) have the right to have an advisor throughout the process. An advisor may be an advocate, parent, friend, staff or faculty member, legal counsel (at your own expense), or the party chooses another person for support. Should you choose to have legal counsel, we ask that you inform the University so the University's Legal Counsel can be told. When you have an advisor, you will be asked to complete the "Authorization to Disclose Information" form allowing the University to release
